

Woods Cross Police Department CITIZEN TRAFFIC COMPLAINT

Utah law provides for the filing of traffic infraction charges by the ***person who observes the violation take place***. In order to successfully prosecute such a case, the reporting party must be willing and able to do at least the following:

- Articulate behavior by the defendant which constitutes a violation of Utah Law.
- Sufficiently describe the suspect vehicle and its operator to assist law enforcement personnel in identifying the alleged offender.
- Appear before the court to sign a complaint.
- Testify in behalf of the state of Utah in any trial resulting from the filing of such charges.
